

LIHEAP stands for Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program. It is designed for people in need of assistance with their energy costs, including electric, wood, coal, oil, gas, LP gas, and kerosene.

About the Program

We offer assistance to help families pay their energy bills. This payment is sent directly to your utility company to be credited on your account. If you qualify, you will receive a letter in the mail telling you the amount of the credit that has been applied.

Once our finance department receives your processed application they request funding from the Tennessee Housing Development Agency (THDA) so we may credit your account. We receive over 11,000 applications annually.

It is extremely important that you **PAY YOUR BILL** while you're waiting to avoid disconnection. We can not pay late fees.
